

WHAT'S HAPPENING

42ND & 43RD STREET CONSTRUCTION

Road construction will be starting shortly on 42 street between 50th Avenue and 53rd Avenue. Expect to see traffic delays and interruptions throughout July and into August. Street lighting construction will be the initial phase followed by concrete sidewalk and curb and gutter installation followed by pavement resurfacing to finish.

43rd Street will also see traffic delays in July between 50th Avenue and the Canalta Hotel due to road construction. Although the plan is to leave the road open as much as possible, there is likely to be lane closures and limited access at times to accommodate various stages of road construction.


